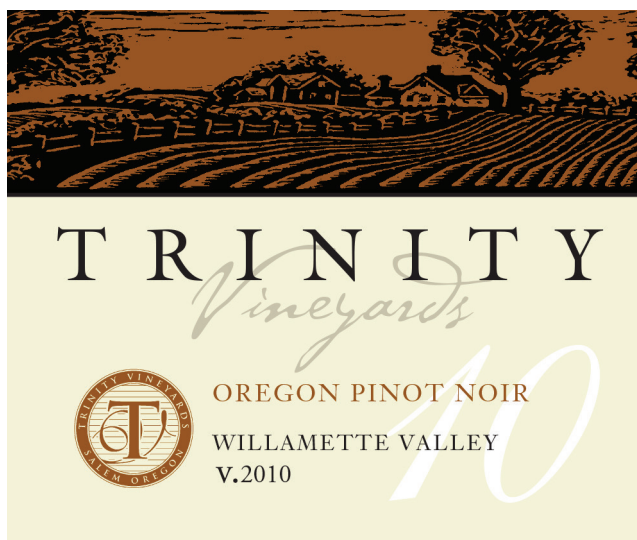

The wine has a hint of funk, plenty of toast, and tart, young rhubarb/cranberry fruit. It needs a bit more time to open up fully, but it's off to a good start. —P.G.
